Application Requirements

- Application Form – Filled out online or on paper
- Signed Guardian Consent Form
- Reference Letter from Teacher or Guidance Counsellor
- 400 word personal essay
- Grade 11 or 12 High School Student
- Applicant self identifies as First Nations, Métis or Inuit
